FROM THE MANAGER'S DESK

TURF TALK



July initiates the stress period for most golf course operations in the Midwest. Diligent care of our bentgrass putting greens is a must for their survival. July typically is the hottest month of the Southern Indiana calendar meaning that proper irrigation, timely cultural practices and afternoon syringing techniques are in full force. Greens tend to be slightly slower during the summer months as rolling is decreased a bit in order to reduce mechanical stress to the turf. For some of the weeks, we'll rotate the two practices of mowing and rolling as a way to reduce man made stress. The higher July humidity also causes puffiness in the turf. This increases leaf friction, which can lead to slower ball roll.

The golf course staff has been busy the last month or so getting the course in pristine condition along with tidying up a few loose ends. Hole repair, addressing the wet spot to the right of #18 fairway and sodding tree stump wells are just a few. As I write to you, we are in the early stages of repairing a few weak areas in our zoysia fairways. The abundant rainfall coupled with poor drainage caused some suffering to the zoysia. We plan to add drainage where needed and replace the damaged grass with new sod. The new tees at #12 will be sodded soon as well.

We are truly proud of the golf course this year. Plan to bring your friends out to enjoy the hard work that is being done. I hope to see everyone soon. If you ever have any questions, please never hesitate to stop me for a conversation.
